



Manitoba Council Girl Guide Award of Excellence Scholarship

Who is eligible for this bursary?

Any current member of Girl Guides in the Province of Manitoba – who has been an active member for a minimum of five years with plans for continuing membership in Manitoba, and who is in their final year of high school with plans of post secondary education.

What is the purpose of this bursary?

To recognize excellence in active Manitoba members of Girl Guides who are continuing in post secondary education.

Deadline for receipt of applications:

Must be received at the Provincial Office **by May 15th (no exceptions)**. Original copies in black ink or typed.

Criteria:

- minimum of 5 years active membership
- recipient must continue membership in Guiding
- cannot receive both a scholarship and a bursary from Manitoba Council in the same year
- only members who are in their last year of high school and have plans to continue their education are eligible
- funds can be used for tuition to an accredited Canadian Post Secondary Institution
- must be used within twelve months of graduation from high school

Candidates will be evaluated in terms of the following:

- Guiding background
- scholastic standing
- most recent marks (report card) and one just previous of high school grades
- awards/honors received from all aspects of her life (not just academic)
- letter from applicant describing what role Guiding plays in her life
- two confidential recommendations (one from a Guider and one from a teacher)
- additional interest and activities
- service/volunteer involvement (inside and outside of Guiding)

Scholarship will be funded by Manitoba Council from:

- interest from the Scholarship/Bursary fund
- donations
- memorial donations

Funding level will be:

\$1,000.00 – Presentation of this award will be made at the recipient's graduation ceremony and at the discretion of the committee (does not have to be awarded each year)

Notification:

All applicants will be notified as soon as the award has been presented (the end of June or early July).
