- Your Visitor's Visa to India
- Your Passport Fees

You may be required to have uniform pieces that you do not own and it will be necessary for you to borrow or purchase these items.

All event costs are based on figures available at the time of circulation of this fact sheet (9 months before the event).

This figure may change slightly due to the increased international airfare and currency fluctuations.

Participation in this event by Canadian representatives is dependent on acceptable health and safety conditions in the country at the time of the event.

Personal travel for adult events is only permitted to a maximum of two weeks, following the event and must depart from the same point of arrival. Consult your Provincial International Director.

If participation is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the Girl Guides of Canada will not accept responsibility for expenses incurred in preparation for this event.

Qualifications: General Qualifications for Adults

Note: In order that as many Members as possible have the opportunity to participate in nationally sponsored international events, Members selected may participate in these events as follows:

- once as a girl Member
- once as a young adult (the young adult category is usually between the ages of 18 and 25, but may vary)
- once as an adult
